What is the LCI Certification?

LCI (Lean Construction Institute) offers certifications that focus on Lean design and construction principles.

The certifications are designed to validate expertise in applying Lean methods effectively in real-world projects.

They require a combination of work experience, knowledge assessments, and a portfolio submission.

TRAINING CERTIFICATE



Results from attending a course Results from a rigorous assessment process

Open to anyone regardless of experience

Requires verified industry experience

Could be developed by anyone Awarded by a standardsetting, national organization

No enforcement

Can be revoked for ethics or other violations

No standard or quality assurance

Standards are set through an industry-wide process

Could be listed on resumé but rarely offers any designation

Results in a designation to use after one's name

Training certificates are usually granted upon the successful completion of a designated educational program, course, or training designed to impart new skills, knowledge, or capabilities.

Training Certificates are valuable on the journey

Industry certifications consist of a formal procedure to validate an individual's practical experience in specific skills, knowledge, or competencies.
